



COMPUTER QUIZ







The students had exhibited their knowledge by rapidly answering the questions. The event proved to be quite productive for the students.






All four houses participated with great zeal and ardour.

GANGA QUEST



- Medical Devices




Moreover, she suggested the three R's approach to minimize the waste i.e

RECYCLE- Recycle (Can't repair anymore? Then recycle.)


The session was very interactive where the students asked ample of questions regarding e - waste management.

After this amazing session, Mohammad Sharifur Rehman, a Sustainable Development Consultant & Social Activist from Bangladesh focussed on Measuring Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in our day to day life. He also talked about the opportunities and challenges for implementing SDGs in schools.

Overall, it was an illuminative session.











When was the last time you saw the sun set into the arms of the night, Not wondering about any joy or sorrow. Just staring into the endless sky, And gazing at the stars that follow.




