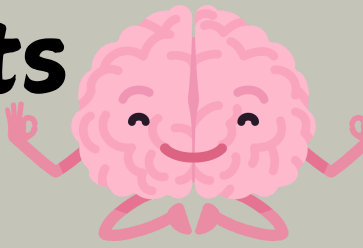

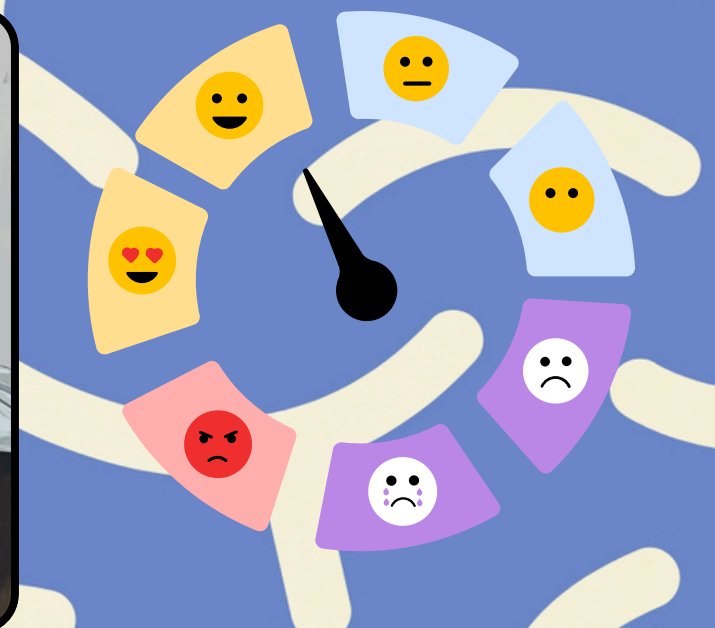
Promoting Mental Health and Wellness among Students

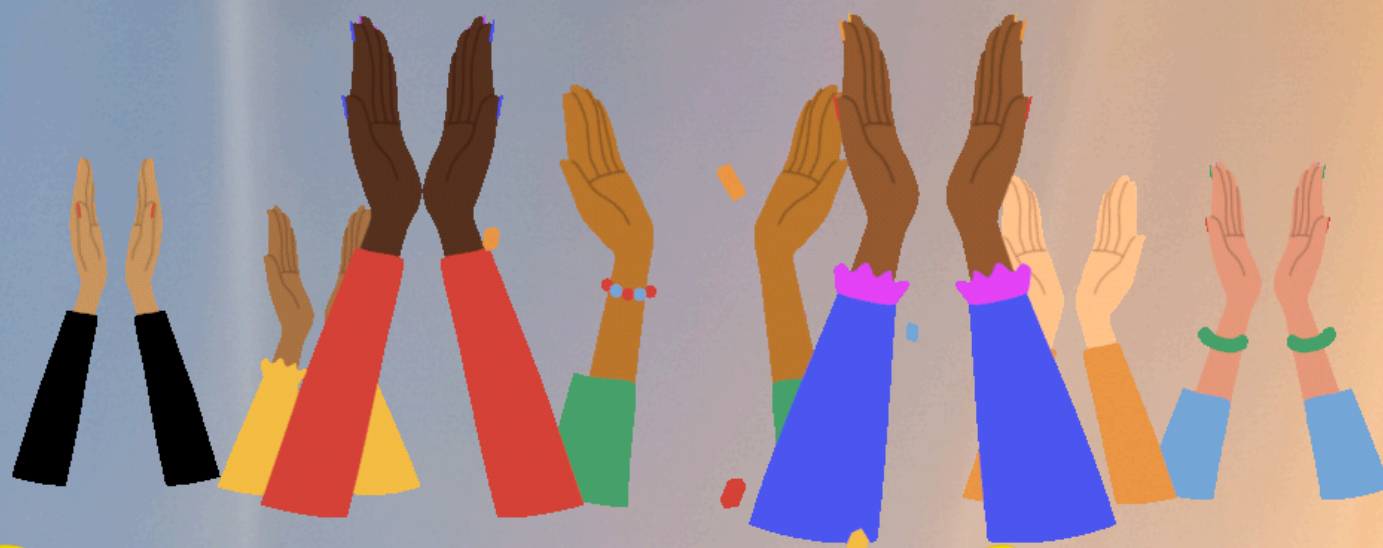
