## Class VI English

### 1. Capture the Magic of Sikkim!

You may decorate your diary page with small drawings, emojis, or pictures of your activities. (Word Limit: 70–80 words)

## Hindi

## Mathematics

1. Prepare a Math Magazine of 10–12 pages. The magazine should be handwritten, colourful, creative, and neatly presented.

### Instructions

- a. Design a creative cover page with a suitable title.
  - Choose any two patterns observed in Sikkim such as: – Flag patterns etc.
  - For each pattern: – Draw and colour it neatly.
  - Give a suitable title.
  - Write where the pattern is observed.
  - Add interesting facts and significance.
  - Mention the mathematical ideas seen in the pattern such as shapes, symmetry, or repeating designs.
- b. After that, collect the population data of any 10 areas of Sikkim and arrange it in ascending order.
- c. Next, write each population figure on a separate page.
  - Write the number in both the Indian and International System of Numeration.
  - Frame one mathematical word problem in such a way that the answer is the given population number.
  - Solve the word problem step-by-step clearly.

## Science

Mission Sikkim: तापमान से विज्ञान तक

You are selected as a Junior Climate Scientist for “Mission Sikkim.” Your task is not just to record the temperature—but also to investigate, analyse, and explain the science behind it!

- Record the daily temperature of Sikkim for 10 days
- Convert each reading from Celsius to unit (Fahrenheit or Kelvin)
- Organize your data into neat tables and create graphs or charts to show temperature variations
- Enhance your report with labels, pictures, and creative presentation

*Think & Explore:*

1. What patterns do you observe in Sikkim’s temperature? Does it remain constant or does it change? What could be the scientific reasons behind these changes?
2. Give your weather report a creative subtitle and conclude it like a true scientist with your observations!

Note- You can use coloured A-3 size sheets for the same.

## **Social Science**

### 1. Festival Calendar

Create a festival calendar of Sikkim with drawings and short descriptions of festivals like Losar and Saga Dawa. (Write about at least 3 festivals)

### 2. Project Making

Topic- India - Unity in diversity

Objective: To understand how people of different cultures, languages, food habits, and traditions live together peacefully in India.

Key points to be included in the project-

- Introduction (Meaning of unity in diversity and why India is called a diverse country)
- Different languages spoken in India
- Variety of food
- Traditional Dresses
- Classical art forms of India
- Different festivals
- Epics of India
- Conclusion (Why unity is important and how diversity makes India beautiful and strong)

3. Revise Chapter 2 (Geography) and Chapter 4 (History) from book and notebook.

### **Guidelines for above activities -**

1. Do the first activity on A4 - size sheets
2. Use pictures, drawings, or printouts to make your festival calendar attractive (Activity 1)
3. Decorate your project nicely. Use pictures to enhance the impact of the content. (Activity 2)
