Mathematics

1. Shape the Spirit of Sikkim – A 3D Mathematical Model

Using the reference picture provided, create an innovative 3D model inspired by Sikkim.

Your model may show a Sikkimese landscape, a monastery, a hillside village, prayer flags, mountain roads, or any other scene connected with Sikkim. The model must be made using mathematical 3D shapes such as:

- Cuboid – buildings, walls, steps
- Cylinder – pillars, prayer wheels, towers
- Cone – mountain peaks, rooftops
- Sphere / hemisphere – decorations, stones, domes
- Prism – roofs, pathways, bridges



Science

Sikkim in a Bottle: Create Your Own Living World!

Design a terrarium using soil, small plants, and natural materials that mimic the rich forests of Sikkim. Your record should show:

- How living (plants, organisms) and non-living (soil, air, water) components interact
- Clear labels identifying producers, consumers, and decomposers
- A simple food chain operating within your mini world
- An explanation of how water and air, cycle inside the bottle to support life add creative labels, neat diagrams, and a catchy name for your mini forest.

Social Science

1. “Discover sacred places of India (Sikkim)” Scrapbook

Prepare a scrapbook on sacred places of India (Particularly sikkim). Include the following in your scrapbook-

- Major sacred places of different religions in India
- Sacred ecology of India
- Different communities of Sikkim
- Sacred places/ pilgrimage sites in Sikkim
- Relevance of sacredness in Sikkim

2. Mini Constitution Booklet

Create a small handmade booklet titled: “My Little Constitution”

Include:

- Key features of the Constitution of India
- Fundamental Rights
- Fundamental Duties
- Preamble
- Directive Principles of State Policy (DPSP)

3. Revise Chapter 1 (Geography) and Chapter 4 (History) from the book and notebook.

- The mini constitution should be self-made. Decorate it beautifully using your creativity.
