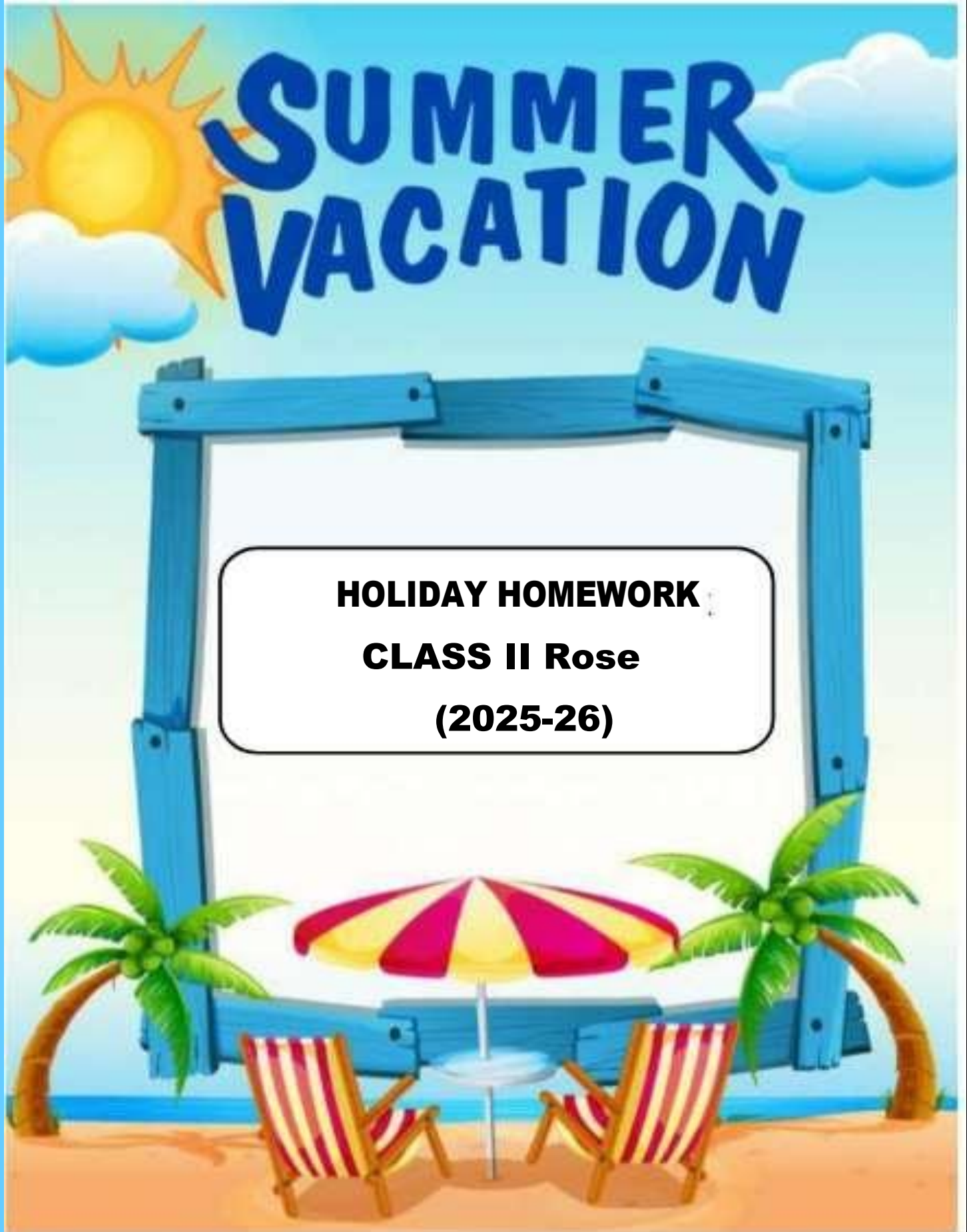

So, with a twinkle in your eyes and a smile on your face, perform each activity while maintaining a healthy balance between your work and play.

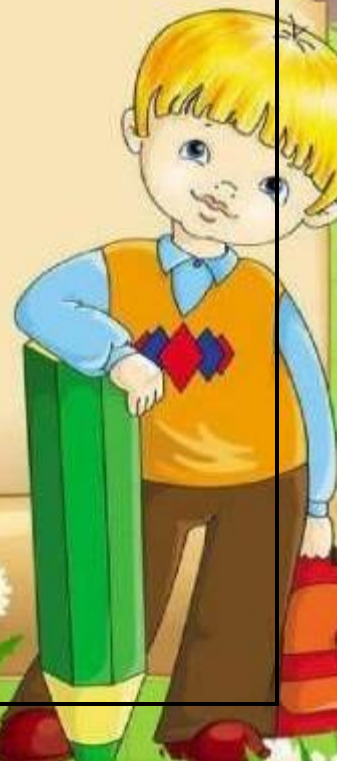

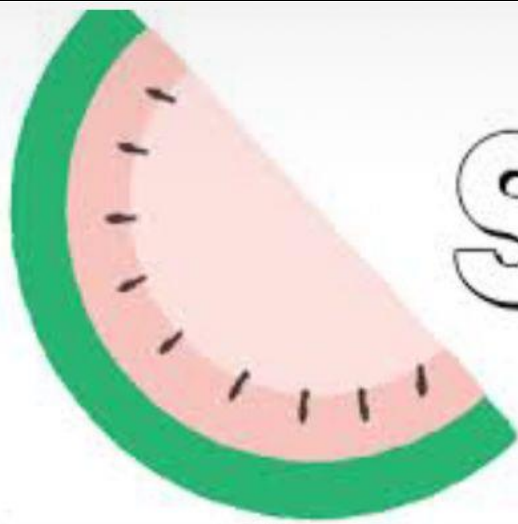

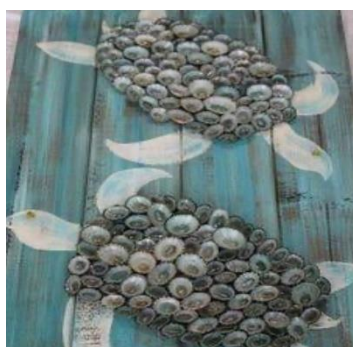
